Dear Students, and Parents/Guardians,

You can expect that I will make every effort to keep you aware of changes in our delivery of any of our resources or even if matters within the district remain status quo. We as a community are in this together and will get through this together. Below I will provide updates on where we as a school stand today.

What does this mean?

During online days, the building is closed to non-essential personnel. If you need to reach a staff member, you will have to do so by email. [CLICK HERE](#) to access the staff email directory. Staff members will be available to answer emails between 9 AM and 1:30 PM; emails that come in after this timeframe may not be returned until the next school day.

Student Academic Expectations

Work will be available for drive-through pick up Wednesday from 9 AM to 6 PM. During that time, if needed, students can be escorted to pick up personal belongings from the building. Any work not picked up will be delivered by Friday afternoon, we will coordinate this delivery with you.

Computers and Technology

For families who do not have a device at home, parents will be able to sign out computers on Wednesday from 9 AM to 6 PM. There will be a technology contract that needs to be signed by a parent, prior to receiving the computer and charger.

Meals

- Wakefield School District will start providing the Wakefield community with breakfast and lunch meals on Thursday, March 19th;
- Meals will be distributed via drive-through at three (3) locations from 7:00 AM - 8:00 AM
 - Greater Wakefield Resource Center
 - East Wakefield Fire Station
 - Paul School

If for some reason these pick-up times do not work for your family, please let us know. We want to make every effort to be sure you have access to these meals.

It is vital for us to know how many meals to provide at the drop off locations. Be assured if you have let us know that you need meal support, you will have those meals delivered to you.

Additionally, families who are experiencing hardship in accessing food should contact Mrs. Wilson, deb.wilson@sau101.org, who will help coordinate with the local food pantry.
