Secondary students and parents who choose to enroll in public schools or public academies other than Spaulding High School are required to confirm their school of choice<u>no later</u> **than December 1st in a request to enter the lottery letter** to the Wakefield School District expressing interest in attending another high school. Letters should be sent to the SAU office, 76 Taylor Way, Sanbornville, NH 03872 or emailed to <u>info@sau101.org</u>.

All applicants will be placed into a lottery. The lottery is a random drawing of numbers whereby each student entered in the pool will be given a number. The student and family will know the outcome of the lottery by number only at the time of the drawing.

The School Board <u>conducts this lottery at their first meeting in January (4th)</u>. Students chosen will be contacted by the Superintendent's office by phone call within 24 hours of the lottery and in writing within 72 hours. The first names drawn that meet the maximum number of students that can attend public high schools other than Spaulding for that given year will be considered for School Board approval. All other names will be placed on a waiting list in order of names drawn. Example: <u>Students selected/approved to attend a school other than Spaulding High School must confirm attendance on or by February 1st. Failure to do so by February 1st will forfeit your position.</u> If six students can attend public high schools other than Spaulding, the first six names drawn will be considered for approval. The seventh name drawn will be placed first on a waiting list; the eighth name drawn will be second on the waiting list and so on.

As a reminder for families of students returning to an approved out-of-district high school, such as Kingswood Regional High School, please confirm your acceptance and continued attendance by December 1st for each following school year.
