She comes with multiple years of experience both as a Licensed Nursing Assistant and working in schools. Her energy and positive attitude is infectious. She is a great addition to our office.

The Paul school will have our annual flu vaccine clinic for students on October 21, 2022. Please be looking for consent forms coming home soon. If you do not wish to use this service, please DO NOT return the form to the school.

As we all know Covid is still among us so please review with your children the importance of hand washing, and covering sneezes or coughs with their elbows.

Should your child exhibit any signs of illness, please keep your child home and test accordingly. Rapid Covid tests are available through the Health Office for student testing by simply calling the Health Office or Administration office.

Covid is just one of many illnesses that quickly spread within a school. Please remember if your child has had a fever, he/she should stay home until that fever has

broken without use of fever medications for a full twenty-four hours. If your child has vomited, please keep him/her home until there have been no vomiting episodes for twenty-four hours. If your child is constantly coughing, he or she will tire and most likely would benefit from staying home for a day or two until that cough calms a bit.

The weather is getting cooler. Please make sure your child/children are dressed appropriately to play outside. Many of our students have mishaps during the day such as: falling in mud and spilling drinks. It would be most helpful to have an extra outfit in your child's backpack for changing into if needed.

Water fountains are still not available to the students during the school day. However, we do have bottle filling stations. Please help us assure your child stays hydrated by providing him/her with a water bottle to use during the day.

There are still a few spaces available for students in grades K-6th. Transportation will be provided daily from the school to the Recreation Department.

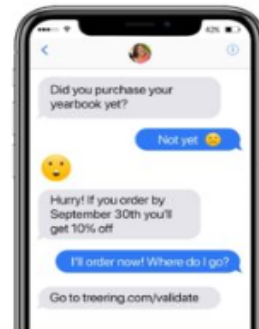

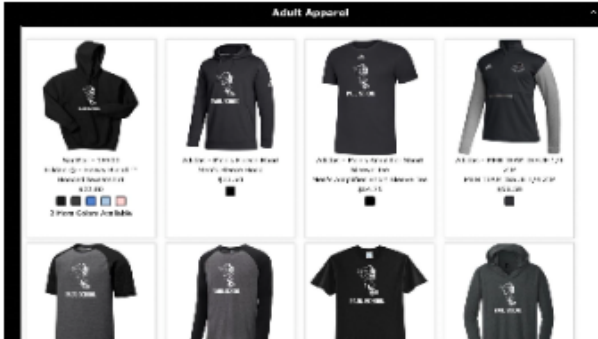
