In Social Studies, students are learning about earlier American history and what events took place that had a significant impact on causing the American Revolution, such as the French and Indian War. In Science the eighth graders started on their first unit on foundational chemistry, they focused on understanding the difference between elements, molecules, compounds and mixtures and began to understand the periodic table of elements, how it works and how it's organized. In Math students are learning about decimals through numbers like Pi. They are also starting to understand how to solve equations that contain different variables. In English students are working to create their own graphic novels, where the main character must become a hero or perform a heroic act to find the answer to the questions "what makes a hero?" The 8th graders are also working on vocabulary and apostrophes.

The 8th grade students have also started their fundraising efforts in order to pay for their end of the year field trip! They are currently selling Little Caesars Pizza Kits, and will soon be creating Candy Grams to sell throughout the month of October. The 8th graders are hoping to raise enough money to visit the city of Boston for a couple of days and possibly go to an amusement park or the beach.
