In music class students are exploring the steady beat through the use of Rhythm Sticks called Lummi Sticks. We are also using our body to feel and create steady beat patterns. Students are also learning to follow simple music notes and create verbal and movement patterns to a steady beat. Students are also learning about string instruments.
