Welcome back Paul School! Please review some helpful information from the health office:

Does your student have asthma or an anaphylactic allergy? Don't forget to drop **inhalers** and/or **EpiPens** off at the health office and complete the forms below:

- **Asthma action plan** - to be completed by a physician
- **Anaphylaxis emergency care plan** - to be completed by a physician
- Physician consent form - to be completed by a physician
- Parent consent form - Required for any medication with a physician's order to be administered at school (including as needed medications)

Please return **emergency information forms** to the school nurse at your earliest convenience (don't forget, this form is 2-sided)

Individual health plans (IHPs) will be sent home for those students who meet criteria (see student handbook) within the next week.

If you would like to make a change to the IHP, please reach out to the school nurse, otherwise, sign and return at your earliest convenience

Immunizations: Please send a copy or have your students' doctors office send a copy of their most recent immunization record to the school nurse. Please see below for a list of the state immunization requirements.
