

EMPLOYEE JOB ACTIONS
(Unauthorized Employee Absences)

Any strike, job action, or withholding of services by a public employee is illegal.

Any employee of the Board who engages in a strike, job action, withholds services, absents himself without leave or authorization, or declines to perform all of his/her duties and responsibilities will be acting contrary to the law of the state, to the School Board policies and to any applicable individual contract.

Any employee who so acts will:

1. Suffer a deduction in salary for every day he/she is absent from work.
2. Have an official reprimand placed in his/her permanent record.
3. Be subject to immediate discharge or other appropriate disciplinary action.
