

FIELD TRIPS AND EXCURSIONS

The Wakefield School Board encourages field trips under the supervision of professional staff members with prior approval of principal.

Field trips are defined as educational trips to observe first hand objects or subjects of classroom instruction. Such trips include nature walks, museum visits, legislative sessions, town meetings, visits to local businesses and other such appropriate activities.

Trips are to be planned in advance, with adequate lead-time to secure written parental permission. Trips are part of the student's educational program. Adequate adult supervision is required.

Any overnight or out of state field trips must have the approval of the Wakefield School Board.
