SCHOOL AGE ENTRANCE

A pupil may enter Kindergarten if his/her chronological age will be five before September 30 of the year of entering school or grade one if he/she will be six before September 30 of the year of entering Grade 1.

A birth certificate must be presented upon registration as proof of the date of birth.

In-coming transfer students in grades 2-12 inclusive will be initially placed in accordance with the data forwarded by the sending district. Such placement is tentative and subject to reassignment by the Superintendent of Schools or his designee.

In-coming transfer students in Grade 1 will be admitted to Grade 1, if previously enrolled in grade one in another school district. Children who reach five years of age between September 30th and October 31st of the year requesting entrance to school will be administered an appropriate developmental evaluation. Children who achieve a satisfactory score will be considered for early admission to kindergarten by the principal. Children who reach six years of age between September 30th and October 31st of the year requesting entrance to school will be administered an appropriate developmental evaluation. Children who reach six years of age between September 30th and October 31st of the year requesting entrance to school will be administered an appropriate developmental evaluation also. Children who achieve a satisfactory score will be considered for early admission to grade 1 by the principal.
