

DETENTION OF STUDENTS

A school administrator or teacher may detain a student for disciplinary reasons during school hours. Further, a school administrator or teacher may detain a student for disciplinary reasons after school hours, provided the parent has been notified.

Parents may be asked to arrange for the transportation of the detained student. A late bus is provided on specific days.

Students who are detained after school must never be left alone during their detention. Their supervision must be provided, or arranged for, by the teacher or administrator who detains them.

Detention after school is not to exceed 60 minutes.

All rules and regulations regarding the detention of students shall be published in the parent/student handbook.
