

PUBLIC GIFTS TO THE SCHOOLS

All gifts given to the schools will become the property of the district.

The Superintendent is authorized to accept gifts to the district, and others whom may designate will be authorized to accept gifts for particular schools, in behalf of the Board. The donor will be officially thanked in the Boards name and all major gifts will be reported to the Board.

In instances where the Superintendent or his designee doubts the appropriateness or usefulness of an offered gift, the matter will be referred to the Board.

The Board welcomes gifts of books and other materials to the school libraries provided that they meet the same standards of selection as those applied to the purchase of library materials.

The Media Coordinator may dispose of gifts at his/her discretion (for example, if the book is out of date or poor physical condition) after review by the principal.
