PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAM

The Wakefield School Board will do its best to keep the people informed of the affairs of the district. To achieve its goals for good school-community relations and maintenance of open two-way channels of communication with the public, the Board authorizes the Superintendent to:

- 1. Prepare or guide the preparation of informational materials including the annual report, newsletters, articles for periodicals, newspapers and/or radio releases, special pamphlets an other assigned material, and to maintain close liaison with news media and publicity organizations.
- 2. Organize or assist in development of speakers' bureaus and speaking engagements with civic, PTA, church and other groups.
- 3. Provide staff members with assistance for preparation of material for community and staff distribution (handbooks, information leaflets, etc.)
- 4. Assist in coordinating work with civic and other groups which support the school system.
