

ACCESS TO PUBLIC SCHOOL PROGRAMS BY NON-PUBLIC, CHARTER SCHOOL AND HOME-EDUCATED PUPILS

The district will comply with the provisions of RSA 193:1-c allowing pupils who attend nonpublic schools, charter schools or are home-educated equal access to the district's curricular courses and co-curricular programs. The district recognizes that any school board policies regulating participation in curricular courses and co-curricular programs, cannot be more restrictive for non-public, public chartered school, or home educated pupils than the policy governing the school district's resident pupils.
